The Proposed WEB Hillsvale Community Solar Project will provide a number of benefits to the West Hants Regional Municipality, and to the province of Nova Scotia.



Subscriptions: Individuals and local businesses can subscribe to the Community Solar Program, and to this project to receive a \$0.02 per kilowatt hour solar energy credit on their power bills.



Local economic benefits: The Proposed WEB Hillsvale Community Solar Project will provide tax revenues to the West Hants Regional Municipality in addition to creating opportunities for local businesses to bid for work and or materials directly supporting local businesses and economies.



Host Community Benefit Program: SWEB intends to form a Host Community Benefit Program with the West Hants Regional Municipality. This program would provide additional financial support to the local communities during the operation of the Proposed WEB Hillsvale Community Solar Project.



Educational Initiatives: Upon operation, SWEB intends to explore the possibility of partnering with Green Schools Nova Scotia or NSCC to host field trips that align with educational curriculum objectives.



Provincial Goals: The Proposed WEB Hillsvale Community Solar Project assists Nova Scotia in achieving its goal to produce 80% of its electricity from renewable energy sources by 2030.
