




New Brunswick Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Process

- Is required by the New Brunswick Department of Environment and Local Government (DELG) to ensure that a Project's environmental effects are minimized.
- Identifies and evaluates environmental effects at an early stage in Project development and recommends mitigation to reduce adverse impacts.
- Public consultation is an integral part of this process. The community is invited to comment on the environmental assessment during the review period.
- Reviewed by NB DELG and other relevant government agencies.
- The New Brunswick Minister of the Environment may issue approval once satisfied that environmental effects have been adequately assessed and addressed.
- Fieldwork for this project has been completed, and results will be disclosed in Q1 2025
