



Project Benefits



Local Economic Benefits: The Proposed White Spruce Wind Energy Project will provide tax revenues for municipal, provincial, and federal governments. The Project is committed to supporting the local economy by prioritizing local workers, services, and materials throughout development, construction, and operations.



Community Revenue Sharing: A share of Project revenues will support local community groups and underrepresented communities in the province. If built, the Project is anticipated to create significant direct and indirect benefits for local stakeholders, including First Nation communities.



Environmental Benefits: The Project is expected to significantly reduce carbon dioxide (CO₂) emissions from New Brunswick's current electricity production and produce enough power for up to 10,210 homes each year.



Provincial Goals: The Proposed White Spruce Wind Energy Project assists New Brunswick with its goal to broaden the inclusion and participation of diverse organizations in the energy sector, and achieve a net-zero electricity system by 2035.
